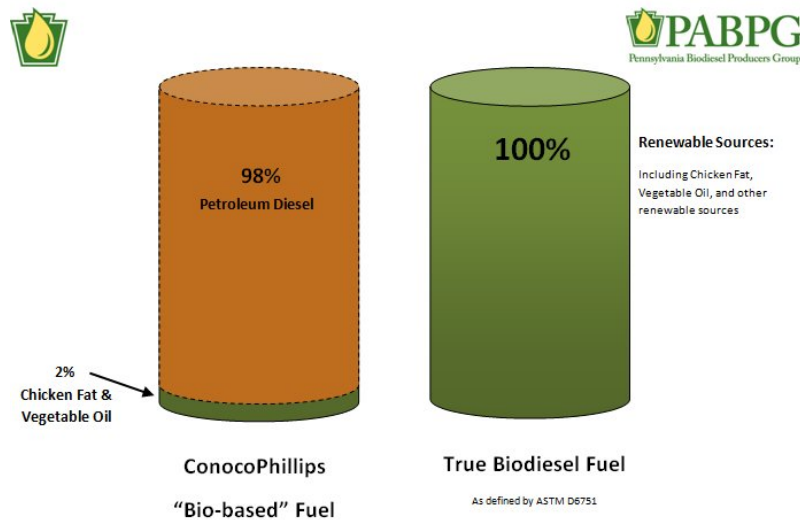




Beware of “Bio-Based” Diesel or “Renewable Diesel”

- “Bio-Based” Diesel is only qualified under ASTM 975
- ASTM 975 is the specification for regular petroleum diesel fuel
- “Bio-Based” Diesel is NOT qualified under ASTM D6751 (The Standard for True Biodiesel)
- Meets EPA Standards, like all regular petroleum fuels, but does not offer any further benefits to the environment
- “Bio-Based” Fuel includes approximately **98% regular petroleum diesel** and only 2% Chicken Fat or Vegetable Oil



1 Gallon of Renewable Sources = 1 Gallon Biodiesel

The PABPG is against any redefinition of biodiesel that would incorporate misleading phrases or misnomers. The PABPG supports True Biodiesel, as qualified under ASTM D6751.
